



## Youth / Educational Groups – Registration

1. Go to <https://education.dailybread.volunteerhub.com/> and choose **Create Account** in the top right corner.
2. Pick a Username and Password and click **NEXT**.
3. On the **Profile** page, fill in your information and click **NEXT** at the bottom.
4. Your account is created, you can now browse the available shifts and submit a booking for your entire group.
5. Once you have picked your shift, click **SIGN UP** and specify your **PARTY SIZE**. Skip the **Email Addresses** field for the other participants. Click **NEXT**.



6. A waiver will be displayed the first time you register for an event and you will have to select the **'I understand and accept the waiver above.'** box and click **NEXT** to proceed.



7. You are registered.

An email will be sent to you confirming the shift. A waiver must be submitted for each youth which can be found [here](#).

## General FAQ

### **Where is Daily Bread's and how do I get there?**

Daily Bread is located at 191 New Toronto Street, M8V 2E7, near Islington and Lakeshore. There is free parking on-site or you can get here **by TTC** by taking the *110C Islington South* from Islington Subway Station and getting off at the **New Toronto Street** exit. We are a short walk east from the bus stop.

### **Is there minimum age to participate?**

Yes, our minimum age to participate during the week is 11 years old and youth aged 11-14 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Youth aged 11-17 years old must have a waiver filled out by their parent/guardian prior to volunteering. These youths are also only allowed to volunteer on our sorting floor.

### **There must be at least one adult (18+) for every six youths aged 11-14.**

Youths aged 8-10 years old are only allowed at our Public Food Sorts which happen in the spring, Thanksgiving, and the end of December.

### **What days and times are the shifts?**

Educational Volunteering happens Tuesdays and/or Thursdays from 10:00 AM-1:00 PM. The shift will sort food from 10:00 AM-12:00 PM followed by a 30 minute lunch and then a tour at 12:30 PM.

### **Is lunch available?**

Lunch is available for \$5 a person and there are both meat and vegetarian options. Lunches must be confirmed at least 5 business days before the shift.
