## WHAT

Daily Bread conducts an annual survey of people who rely on food banks. We need volunteers to conduct surveys for two to three hour shifts.

## WHY

Daily Bread Food Bank believes that research is critical to creating social change to reduce poverty. Daily Bread collects data and publishes reports based on the information. The statistics collected reflect real issues that affect food bank clients. This information helps promote changes by the government that improve the lives of children and adults living in poverty. They are also used to educate the public on Toronto's hunger crisis so they can enlist in the fight against hunger by pushing the government for change.
